(a) to (e) A statement is laid on the table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to Parts (a) to (e) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No.396 on 20.02.2014 to be asked by Shri P.C. Gaddigoudar, Member of Parliament regarding "National Water Mission".

(a) to (e) The National Water Mission (NWM) was established as part of National Action Plan on Climate Change of Government of India. The goals envisaged including the strategies identified under the National Water Mission are given in Annexure-I.

For implementation of National Water Mission during XII Five Year Plan, the Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) of the Ministry of Finance recommended an amount of Rs. 196 (one hundred ninety six) crore for implementation of National Water Mission during the XII Plan period and communicated the same on 25.10.2013.

As against earmarked outlay of Rs. 2.00 crore as Revised Estimate (RE) for the Financial Year 2013-14, the expenditure incurred until 13.02.2014 on this account has been Rs.60.84 Lakh.

Action has been initiated to achieve the goals of the National Water Mission during XII Plan as per details at Annexure-II.
