- (a) whether the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued any notice to the Kingfisher Airlines;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the progress made in the matter so far?

**Answer**

(a) to (c): As on date, Kingfisher airlines does not have valid Air Operator permit (AOP) to operate scheduled operations. Kingfisher airlines stopped their operation with effect from 01st October 2012. Their AOP No S-12 dated 26/08/2003 issued to the airlines was suspended on 20/10/2012 and their AOP stands lapsed from 31/12/2012.
