(a) and (b): Yes, Madam. As per Turn Around Plan (TAP) and Financial Restructuring Plan (FRP) approved by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), Air India is to Monetize its Assets and generate Rs. 5000 crs. over a period of 10 years. Air India has identified following properties for Monetization in the near future:

Within the Country:

- 1. Land and Building at Air India Colony, Kolkata
- 2. Residential Flat No.6B, Middleton Street, Kolkata
- 3. Land at Coimbatore
- 4. Air India Plot No.37/13 at DLF, Qutab Enclabe, Phase-III, Gurgaon.
- 5. Plot of Land (Lakshmi House), at Mount Road, Teynampet, Chennai.
- 6. 4 Flats at Sterling Apartment, Mumbai
- 7 Plot at Baba Kharak Singh Marg, New Delhi

Abroad:

- 1. 2 Flats in Hong Kong
- 2. Two Storied Residential Property at Mauritius
- 3. Residential Bungalow (G+1) at Nairobi, Kenya
- (c): The Air India Management has decided to monetize its assets in accordance with the Government Procedure and Guidelines issued from time to time.
