## Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of women in cities and rural unorganized sector who are enjoying crà che facility as on date;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to convert anganwadi centres into 'day care centres cum creches'; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA TIRATH)

- (a) The crÃ"che facility is available under Rajiv Gandhi National CrÃ"che Scheme for Childen of Working Mothers for both organized and un-organized sectors. At present there are 23,555 functional creches, 16393 creches for rural/tribal areas and 7162 creches for urban areas, each crÃ"che can accommodate upto 25 babies.
- (b) & (c): Under the strengthened and restructured ICDS, approved by the Government of India, 5% of the existing Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) are to be converted into AWC-cum-Crà che. Thus, a total of 70,000 AWCs will be converted into AWC-cum-Crà che during XII Plan. During 2013-14, 12653 AWCs have been approved for conversion into AWC-cum-Crà che. States/UTs will have the flexibility in choosing such AWCs.
