- (a): The women and child oriented schemes being implemented in the Southern States, including Karnataka through anganwadi centres are Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls (RGSEAG)-Sabla, Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) and Indira Gandhi Matritava Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY). The amount allocated/spent in the southern states including Karnataka on these schemes for the last three years and the current year are given in Annexure-1.
- (b): State-wise, scheme-wise achievements under the schemes are given in Annexure-2.
