**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposals from Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) pertaining to renovation and upgradation of Parvati Water Treatment Plant and the Storm Water Line (Phase-II) in Pune;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the funds Proposed to be released to PMC for the above said projects; and
- (c) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SMT. DEEPA DASMUNSHI)

- (a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Under Urban Infrastructure & Governance (UIG) Sub-Mission of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM), two Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) namely,
- (i) Renovation and upgradation of Parvati Water Treatment Plant and
- (ii) the Storm Water Line (Phase-II) have been approved. Ministry of Finance has been requested to release the 1st Installment of both the approved projects. Details of both projects and implementation time are annexed.
