(a)to(c):Yes Madam, the Union Territory of Lakshadweep Administration (UTLA) is augmenting the shipping services for passenger between mainland and islands of Lakshadweep by acquisition of two additional passenger-cum-250 Ton Cargo vessels. The construction of these vessels is being undertaken by Colombo Dockyard in Sri Lanka. The expected delivery for the first vessel is by March, 2014 and for the second vessel by July, 2014.
