- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. This Ministry has a well-defined methodology for regularly assessing the progress made by scientists engaged in research in various research institutions under the Ministry. It is done at various levels by the research/scientific advisory councils and by the Governing Councils of respective Institutes. The outputs are monitored in terms of parameters like refereed research papers published, intellectual property secured, know-how/ process/ product/ technology developed, human resource developed, socio-economic impact created, etc.
- (c) & (d): The research institutions under the Ministry follow Central Government/ UGC Pay Scales and allowances as implemented from time to time.
