FUNCTIONING OF GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS

**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

(a) whether the Government has conducted any survey to find out the present status of functioning of the All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh and Central Government controlled medical hospitals/associated hospitals;

(b) if so, the details/outcome thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to improve the functioning of these hospitals?

**Answer**

(c): Six new AIIMS have been established to reduce burden on existing hospitals and establishment of National Cancer Institute as a part of AIIMS, New Delhi at Jhajjar, Haryana and satellite centre of PGIMER, Chandigarh at Sangrur, Punjab have also been approved.

Several other steps taken by the Government include re-development of infrastructure and facilities/ expansion of various hospitals, up-gradation of some existing hospitals, renovation /modernization of existing wards/ operation theaters/ new OPD at AIIMS, New Delhi and providing state of art computerized queuing and registration system at various hospitals.
