(a)&(b): The Working Group on Urban Poverty, Slums and Service Delivery System constituted by the Planning Commission for 12th Five Year Plan has opined that it is not possible to fix target in respect of housing requirements and consequently required land for 12th Five Year Plan due to non-availability of data on trends of slum-improvement and reduction of poverty. However, this Ministry had fixed a target of 2 million dwellings in urban areas under the Schemes of Rajiv Awas Yojana (1 million) and Rajiv Rinn Yojana (1 million) for the 12th Plan period.
