- (a) & (b) The National Trust for Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities was set up in 1999 through an Act of Parliament. The main objectives of the National Trust is to ensure that the persons with disabilities suffering from autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and multiple disabilities live with dignity, to support and strengthen non government organization and other service providers working in the field of empowering these Persons with Disabilities and to appoint legal guardian to take care of their needs. The National Trust works through the State Nodal Agency Centres, Registered Organization and Local Level Committees.
- (c) & (d) The number of beneficiaries, amount spent/released by the National Trust for Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities under its schemes namely Niramaya, Sahyogi, Aspiration, Samarth and Gharaunda during the last three years and in the current financial year, State-wise, are at Annexure-I-II, Annexure-III, Annexure-IV, Annexure-V and Annexure-VI respectively.
