- (a) whether the Government has received proposal from the various State Governments under the Intensive Cotton Development Programme (CDP);
- (b) if so, the details of proposals received for various States; and
- (c) the details of the Central assistance released under the programme during the last three years and the current year to various State Governments including Jammu and Kashmir, State-wise?

- (a): Yes, Madam. Proposals have been received from the States implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Mini Mission-II of Technology Mission on Cotton (TMC) previously known as intensive Cotton Development Programme (ICDP).
- (b) & (c): The proposals received from various States under Mini Mission-II of Technology Mission on Cotton, includes components like transfer of technologies through field demonstrations, training of farmers and extension workers as well as supply of critical inputs such as certified seeds of varieties/hybrids not older than 15 years, sprayers, pheromone traps, bio-agents and water-saving devices like sprinklers and drip irrigation system. Jammu and Kashmir is not covered under the scheme.
