- (a) the outlay earmarked for conservation of threatened breed of small Ruminants, Pigs, Pack Animals, Equine and Yak during the Eleventh Five Year Plan period;
- (b) the details of funds allocated during the above period, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has fixed any target to achieve the desired objectives; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the results achieved there in so far?

- (a) to (b) 11th Plan Outlay for the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Conservation of Threatened Breeds of Small Ruminants, Pigs, Pack Animals, Equine and Yak during the 11th Five Year Plan was ` Rs. 16.00 crore which was enhanced to `Rs. 45.00 crore during 2008-09 and the scheme renamed "Conservation of Threatened Breeds of Livestock". Details of funds released during the 11th Five Year Plan to various States are given in Annexure-I.
- (c) to (d) Year wise Targets and Achievements under the scheme during the 11th Five Year Plan are given in Annexure -II.
