- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. More than 80 improved varieties and hybrids of paddy have been released for commercial cultivation in different ecosystems during the last three years. Details of these are given in Annexure-I
- (c) The improved high yielding varieties/hybrids have played significant role in enhancing production and productivity of rice. The production of rice during last three years is as under:

2007-08 96.69

2008-09 (4th advance estimate) 99.15
