- (a) whether the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has initiated an audit of maintenance procedure of major airlines to check whether the projected losses in this fiscal year are leading to a compromise on passenger safety;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether some airlines are not following proper safety measures in view of losses; and
- (d) if so, the measures taken to ensure that the airlines are adopting complete safety measures?
