Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of private aircraft and chartered flights that take off daily from Delhi and Mumbai Airports;
- (b) whether it is proposed to build separate terminals for them to ease congestion at these airports; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a): On an average, 25 private and chartered flights takes off daily from Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport, Delhi and 15 private and chartered flights takes off from Chhatrapati Shivaji International (CSI) Airport, Mumbai.

(b)&(c): As per Master Plan of IGI Airport, Delhi provision exists for a n exclusive terminal for general aviation flights.A separate General Aviation Terminal has been commissioned at CSI Airport,Mumbai to cater to the requirements of domestic and international general aviation flights.
