Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received requests from the various State Governments for construction of new hangers for parking of State Government Helicopters;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government on each proposal so far?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a), (b) & (c): From time to time, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has received requests from various State Governments for allotment of land for construction of hanger for housing/parking/maintenance of State Government's aircrafts/helicopters. So far, AAI has allotted land at Bhopal airport to Government of Madhya Pradesh, Ahmedabad Airport to Government of Gujarat, Begumpet airport to Government of Andhra Pradesh and Lucknow airport to Government of Uttar Pradesh. The request for allotment of land at Chennai airport from Government of Tamil Nadu and Amritsar from Government of Punjab has also been received.
