(b) whether the supply of pesticides is less than the demands made by the various State Governments including West Bengal;

(c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(d) the reasons therefor; and

(e) the steps being taken by the Government for the adequate supply of pesticides in the country?

(a) to (e): The statement showing State-wise consumption of pesticides during the last three years is annexed. The Central Government reviews availability of agricultural inputs, including pesticides, with the States during Zonal Conferences organized prior to Kharif and Rabi seasons. The supply of pesticides in the States is regulated by the State Governments. There is no shortage of pesticides in the States/Union Territories, including West Bengal, as reported by representatives of the States in the Zonal Conferences organized prior to Kharif and Rabi seasons in 2009.
