(a) to (c): Deficient rainfall has an impact on fertilizer use, particularly in rainfed/dryland areas where scarcity of water poses high risk on fertilizer use. Interventions like efficient crop planning, rain water harvesting, soil and water conservation, use of compost/vermicompost etc. can help in minimizing the risk of crop failure, paving the way for greater fertilizer use in rainfed areas. The Government is providing assistance to the State Governments for watershed development programmes in the country under various schemes to assist the farmers.
