- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the provisions of the MVL proposed to be amended;
- (c) the time by which the said law is likely to be implemented and the benefits likely to acrue therefrom; and
- (d) the details of India's ranking in the latest World Road Statistics?

## **Answer**

- (a)to (c) Yes, Sir. A Committee has been constituted by the Government to review the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 comprehensively to make Act is a long drawn legal process. As such no definite time frame for finalization of the proposal could be envisaged at this stage.
- (d) In terms of injury and corresponding number of persons killed, India ranks 4th as per World Road Statistics(WRS) 2008.
