(a) Yes, Sir. This Ministry has come across a news report regarding the study conducted by Centre for Transforming India (CTI) which states that a huge quantity of fuel is wasted on certain road stretches in Delhi due to traffic jams and lacunae in public transport system.

(b) The traffic conditions vary from state to state and even on different stretches in a city itself. Proper traffic planning as well as control and regulation of traffic is the responsibility of the State Government.
