(a) & (b) : Allocation of funds for development, including construction/widening of National Highways (NHs) is done State-wise and not NH-wise or project-wise. Development and maintenance and repairs of NHs is a continuous process and these are taken up based on the availability of funds, traffic density and inter-se priority of works. State-wise details of funds allocated for development/construction/widening of NHs for the years 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 are given in Annexure.
