(a) and (b): Yes, Sir. An appeal has been made to all the Senior Executives (General Managers & above) to forego their salary & Productivity Linked Incentives for the month of July 2009 on a voluntary basis. The response was largely positive.

(c) and (d): Yes, Sir. The approximate saving on this account will be Rs. 1.5 crores.
