## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) Whether Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has issued guidelines to do away the differences in call rates on intranetworks and inter-networks to ensure equal call rates on every network;

(b) If so, the details thereof;

(c) The details of the compliance by private telecom companies about the guidelines of TRAI as on date, separately;

(d) whether the Government proposes to take action which are following the guidelines of TRAI; and

(e) If so, the details thereof?

## Answer

(b) Does not arise in view of (a) above

(c) & (d) As per the currently prevailing tariff framework it is permissible for operators to provide differential call charges for off-net (inter network) and on-net (intra network) calls. Therefore, there is no violation of guidelines issued by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) in case a service provider offers differential call rates in respect of intra network and inter network calls.

(e) Does not arise in view of (c) & (d) above.
