STORM WATER DRAINAGE SCHEME AT SILCHAR

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has sanctioned funds for Storm Water Drainage Scheme at Silchar (Assam);
- (b) if so, whether the work started by the National Building Construction Corporation (NBCC) has been stopped;
- (c) if so, the reason therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the work is likely to be restarted and completed?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. The Government has sanctioned funds for Storm Water Drainage Scheme at Silchar in Assam. The work was started by National Building Construction Corporation but the work could not progress due to local operational difficulties. At the request of the State Government, the project was transferred from NBCC to the State Government. The State Government shall complete the project within three years.
