(a) to (d) : The Government recognizes the importance of strengthening planning and resource mobilization in order to enable the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) to meet the challenges of urbanization. Towards this objective it is supporting implementation of the urban sector reforms including property tax reforms, rationalization of stamp duty, implementation of double entry accounting systems, e-governance, levy of reasonable user charges, empowerment of ULBs in pursuance of 74th Constitutional Amendment Act and encouraging public private partnerships. The government has also been advocating innovative means of financing urban infrastructure through the 'Tax free Municipal Bonds' and the 'Pooled Finance Development Scheme' etc.
