- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of the view points expressed by the State level parties?

- (a)&(b): Yes, Sir. Ministry of Rural Development had convened a meeting with leaders of State Level Political Parties on 6.10.2009 to discuss NREGA and invitations had been sent to 43 regional parties. Leaders/representatives of 7 parties however, participated in the meeting.
- (c): The main views/suggestions made by the participants are as under:
- (i) Need for strict monitoring of the implementation of the Act.
- (ii) Revision in the wage rates notified by the Centre.
- (iii) Creation of durable assets under NREGA
- (iv) Awareness generation among rural households about NREGA.
- (v) Expansion of the scope of permissible works
- (vi) Revision of existing wage and material ratio.
