(b) the total number of mercy petitions pending with the Union Government; and

(c) the time by which such mercy petitions are likely to be cleared?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

(a): As on 31-12-2007, 308 convicts are lodged in various jails facing death penalty in the country.

(b): 29 mercy petitions involving 52 death convicts are pending with the Union Government under Article 72 of the Constitution.

(c): The power under Article 72 of the Constitution does not contain any limitation as to the time, in which the power conferred might be exercised.
