- (a) the number of heavy industries operating in Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh and investment made;
- (b) whether some big companies have expressed their interest to set up industries in the Vidarbha region of Maharashtra; and
- (c) if so, the details along with the number of companies to be set up and number of persons to get employment?

(a) to (c): There is no formal classification of Industries as "Heavy". Further, the information on industries operating in various states is not centrally maintained. However, on the basis of the Part B of IEMs filed by the entrepreneurs and Industrial Licences issued, the details of industries set up in the state of Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh since August 1991 to October 2009 are as follows:

And currently there are 19 applications for grant of Industrial Licence with the Government for the state of Maharashtra with proposed employment for 1380 persons.
