STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 316 BY SHRIMATI J. SHANTHA AND SHRI SUGUMAR K. TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 10.12.2009 REGARDING SUPPLY OF CONCRETE SLEEPERS

- (a) & (b): No, Madam. A close watch is kept on the availability of sleepers for various projects/track renewal works.
- (c) & (d): A constant review is made by Ministry of Railways to augment sleeper production and to set up new plants in various Zonal Railways including Southern Zones of Indian Railways. In Southern Zone, it has been approved to set up three new plants on South Western Railway and one plant on South Central Railway.
- (e): Besides setting up of new sleeper plants, Ministry of Railways has taken steps to shift concrete sleeper plants from surplus Railways to deficient Railways.
