- (a) the details of Special Economic Zones (SEZs) proposed and developed in Haryana so far;
- (b) whether any proposals for setting up SEZs in Haryana are pending with the Government; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): Out of 45 formally approved SEZs in Haryana, 31 have since been notified. Notification of a SEZ is done only on compliance of requisite statutory requirements. As regards new proposals for setting up of SEZs, including those in Haryana, the Board of Approval (BOA) considers them only when the concerned State Government recommends and the proposal is found to be complete in all respects.
