(a) & (b): No,Madam.Relief Trains proceeding to the site of accident are accorded highest priority for movement.Further,steps taken by the Railways to ensure prompt reaching of Accident Relief Trains (ARTs) include prescribing minimum time for despatch of ARTs after an accident, progressively increasing the speed of ARTs to 100 kilometers per hour, introduction of Self Propelled Accident Relief Trains, etc.
