## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H.MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) Lucknow-Barabanki rail line is already electrified. Gorakhpur-Gonda-Barabanki rail line is a part of Barauni-Gorakhpur-Gonda-Barabanki (729 Route Kilometres) electrification project on which work is in progress.
- (b) The project was sanctioned at a cost of Rs.679.96 crore in May 2007. Rs.94.32 crore has been allotted for this project during 2009-10.
- (c) The electrification of entire section is targeted by June 2012.
