(a) to (c) Yes,Madam.A work of construction of Road over bridge has been sanctioned in Financial year 2008-09 in lieu of level crossing no. A-55/E-3 on Meerut-Hapur section. The cost of the work is Rs.21.36crores.Preliminary works e.g. preparation of detailed estimate, approval of General Arrangement Drawing etc. are in progress.
