- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): 5 pairs of trains are presently running between Firozpur Cantt Jn. and Fazilka Jn. All these trains are already stopping at Firozpur Cantt Jn, Firozpur City and Fazilka Jn.
- (c) & (d) At present, there is no proposal for introduction of additional train on Firozpur Cantt and Fazilka Jn. section.
