Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of seats/berths reserved for the VIP's in the trains running from Nanded to Amritsar, Nanded to Mumbai and Nanded to Hyderabad, class-wise;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to increase this quota;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Railways propose to increase the number of seats/berths in the 1st Class AC and 2nd Class AC in these trains due to growing demand; and
- (e) if so, the time by which the proposal is likely to be implemented?

Answer

- (a): The class-wise details of emergency quota available at Nanded in trains going towards Amritsar, Mumbai and Hyderabad are enclosed as Appendix.
