## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a): Mandya railway station in Karnataka has been selected as modern station for the purpose of modernization and giving a face lift.
- (b) to (d): Some of the important works completed at Mandya station include face-lifting and remodeling of station building, improvement to circulating area to ensure proper entry/exit of vehicles etc. improved, modern, cost effective lighting arrangements at platforms, concourse, etc, renovated water booth, renovated modern "Pay & Use" toilets, waiting and retiring room with modern furniture, platform extension to accommodate longer trains and provision of facilities for handicapped persons.

Improvement to the Passenger Reservation System (PRS) Office, construction of RPF out-post and covering of existing foot over bridge are planned for completion by 31st March, 2010.
