EXTENSION AND MODERNISATION OF MANDYA RAILWAY STATION

- (a) whether the Railways have any proposal for extension and modernisation of Mandya Railway Station in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the time by which this project is likely to be started and scheduled to be completed; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

- (a): Mandya railway station in Karnataka has been selected as modern station for the purpose of modernization and giving a face lift.
  - (b) to (d): Some of the important works completed at Mandya station include face-lifting and remodeling of station building, improvement to circulating area to ensure proper entry/exit of vehicles etc. improved, modern, cost effective lighting arrangements at platforms, concourse, etc, renovated water booth, renovated modern "Pay & Use" toilets, waiting and retiring room with modern furniture, platform extension to accommodate longer trains and provision of facilities for handicapped persons.
- Improvement to the Passenger Reservation System (PRS) Office, construction of RPF out-post and covering of existing foot over bridge are planned for completion by 31st March, 2010.
