- (b) whether the Government proposes to allocate plan fund to BTC on the line of Central funds allocated to other small States, so as to take up new developmental activities; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

- (a): The Government of Assam has informed that they have a policy for overall development of areas falling under jurisdiction of Bodoland Territorial Council (BTC). The Government of Assam releases plan and non-plan funds to BTC in two installments every year.
- (b) & (c): In pursuance of Memorandum of Settlement signed between the Government of India, Government of Assam and Bodo Liberation Tiger (BLT) in the year 2003, the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER) has sanctioned 42 projects worth Rs. 476.26 crore for creation of socio-economic infrastructure since the year 2004-05 and Rs. 437.05 crore has been released to the State Government of Assam. There is no proposal to allocate funds directly to BTC.
