- (a) & (b): Yes Madam. Efforts are being made to have Sign Language Research and Training Centres which will inter-alia devoted to the development and promotion of Sign Language and Training.
- (c): Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre (ISLRTC) will start in the year 2010-11. There are six centres in the country offering training in Indian Sign Language located at Mumbai, New Delhi, Kolkotta, Bhubneshwar, Secundrabad and Indore.
- (d): Rs.12.15 crore for a period of 5 years with a recurring cost of Rs.9.31 crore and Non- recurring cost of Rs.2.84 crore.
- (e): Likely to be implemented in the year 2010-11.

- (i) The technical education is being made deaf friendly by training the Instructors in ITI's and Polytechnic in modes of communication.
- (ii) Inclusive education is being supported through research and development, and
- (iii) Both general education and special education courses are being suitably modified to promote inclusive education.
