**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is any proposal to step up the recruitment process in para-military forces;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor;
- (c) the time by which the entire process is likely to be completed and the estimated expenditure likely to be incurred on the process; and
- (d) the extent to which the security system of the country would be strengthened as a result thereof?

(a) to (d): Recruitment in Central Para Military Forces is an ongoing process with the help of UPSC, SSC and Force recruitment boards. Recruitment is a continuous process throughout the year among different Forces. The expenditure in recruitment is incurred as per need. The need for recruitment arises mainly due to sanction of new posts following expansion and to filling up vacancies due to retirement, resignation etc. The induction of manpower strengthens the security system of the country.
