(a) & (b): As per the guidelines laid down by the Planning Commission, Ministry has been pressing the concerned State Governments for earmarking funds under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP), in proportion to at least the tribal population of the State. As per information available for 2008-09, the State Governments of Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharastra, Manipur, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tripura, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand and West Bengal have made adequate fund allocation in proportion to the tribal population of the State.
