(a) to (d) During the current financial year, no request has been received by the Ministry from the State Government of Karnataka for allocation of funds for repairs. So far, an allocation of Rs.18.37 Crore towards maintenance and repairs of National Highways has been made for the State of Karnataka during 2009-10 on the basis of Vote on Account passed by the Parliament. Further allocation will be made after the Budget for the current financial year is passed by the Parliament.
