- (b) if so, the details thereof location-wise; and
- (c) the cost of setting each of these Radars?

- (a) Yes Madam. Government is currently commissioning about 16 Doppler Weather Radar (DWR) Stations under the Phase-I of the Modernization Programme of the India Meteorological Department's (IMDs)
- (b) The DWR Stations are being established at Patiala (Punjab), Delhi Airport (Delhi), Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh), Hyderabad (Andhra Pradesh), Nagpur (Maharashtra), Mumbai (Maharashtra), Goa (Goa), Karaikal (Pondicherry), Paradip (Orissa), Patna (Bihar), Mohanbari (Assam), Agartala (Tripura), Bhuj (Gujarat), Kochi (Kerala), Mausam Bhavan (New Delhi) and Jaipur (Rajasthan).
- (c) An allocation of Rs. 474.56 Crores is made during the XI Plan for setting up DWR Stations.
