**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of private sector power projects expected to be commissioned in the country during the next three years;
- (b) the quantum of power likely to be generated after the commissioning of these projects;
- (c) whether the work on these projects has been going on as per the schedule;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has made any assessment of the contribution of private sector in the power generation in the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI)

(a) to (d): 27 power projects in the Private Sector with an estimated installed capacity of 20687 MW are expected to be commissioned during 2009-10 to 2011-12. Construction of most of these power projects are generally going on as per schedule. Details are at Annex-I and Annex-IA.

(e) & (f): Share of private sector in the total installed capacity in the country is about 17% at present.
