## **Answer**

- (a) The measures of Human Development Indices (HDI) and Income Indices at the district level are not available for all the States in India. As per the available data on tribal dominated districts from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) on HDI and Income Indices given in the enclosed Statement, there is a general pattern of close association between the two indices, although there are instances of divergence between these two indices in some cases.
- (b) & (c) The Government does not have any proposal for having different indicators measuring the economic progress for different segments of population. Most of the States are using HDI as a measure of progress.
