- (a) to (c): The details of Central financial assistance released and utilised for implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education in the country for the last three years and the current year/ State-wise is at Annexure I. Financial assistance is released to the State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) in two installments in any financial year. Financial assistance of 1st installment for the current year i.e. 2014-15 has been released to all the State Governments/UTs as per their approved Annual Work Plan.
- (d) to (e): Under the Central Government's flagship programme, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan, funding is provided for teacher training programmes to build capacities of secondary teachers. Additionally, under RMSA with a view to providing quality education for improving the teaching skills of teachers, various interventions including induction training of teachers, in- service training of Principals and Teachers, Training of Master Trainers, training of Key Resource Persons, School Leadership Development Programme are being funded.
