(a) to (d) Two Working Groups comprising Vice Chancellors of Central Universities were constituted during the Retreat of Vice Chancellors of Central Universities with Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development at Chandigarh on 12-13th September, 2014. One Working Group was constituted to deliberate on the issues of Common Admission, Common Curriculum, Student Mobility, Faculty Mobility and National Credit Transfer. Another Working Group was constituted to develop framework for National Ranking System.

The Working Group on Common Admissions etc., has submitted its report to this Ministry.
