- (a) whether the Government has proposed to promote creative research works in the field of Hindi Language and Literature and to link with employment and market in the era of globalisation;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to provide language lab, computer, internet and Wi-Fi facility to bring uniformity in educational posts in departments of Hindi in all universities of the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b): Kendriya Hindi Sansthan (KHS), Agra, an autonomous organisation under this Ministry is engaged in research works regarding the teaching of Hindi. The output of research is used for Teaching & Learning Material (Audio-Visual & Multimedia programmes) production for the Trainees/Students of Non-Hindi States and abroad as well. Under the 'Poorvottar Samagri Nirman Pariyojana' the Depart- ment of Material Production for North East has produced two volumes of creative literature of North East India named 'Mizo Lok Sahitya' and 'Manipuri Lok Sahitya' . Under the 'Bhasha Sahitya C.D. Nirman Pariyojana' the Department of Information and Language Technology has produced two video documentaries namely 'Panth Rahne Do Aparichit', a film based on creative research of the life and works of Mahadevi Verma, and 'Aadaminamah', a film based on creative research on the life and works of Nazeer Akbarabadi, four audio programmes under the 'Hindi Surabhi' series based on the representative poetic works of various poets.
- (c) & (d): KHS has provided Language Lab, Internet and Wi-Fi facility to enhance the quality of Teaching & Training. The University Grants Commission has approved different teaching posts for establishment and upgradation of departments of Hindi in 17 universities which include provisions of Language lab, computer, internet and Wi-Fi facility.
