STATEMENT TO BE LAID ON THE TABLE OF THE LOK SABHA IN RESPECT OF PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 12 FOR 24TH NOVEMBER, 2014 REGARDING "EXTENSION OF SPECTRUM HOLDINGS".

(a) & (b) M/s Bharti Airtel, M/s Vodafone, M/s Idea Cellular and M/s Reliance Communications Ltd. whose licenses are expiring during 2015 and 2016 have jointly requested Government for allowing them to continue with their existing in-use spectrum, till adequate additional spectrum, as recommended by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), is made available for the conduct of auction.

(c) Government has already de-licensed spectrum bands in 2.4 GHz and 5.8 GHz for Wi-Fi services. Auction of spectrum in 800 MHz, 900 MHz and 1800 MHz bands is planned during the current financial year.
